1. Purpose

2. Related laws and regulations

- 2.2 The Air Registration (Fees) (Jersey) Order, 2015.

3. Definitions

4. The Registers

The following registers are available for inspection by the public:

- The Aircraft Register;
- The Engine Register;
- The Charges Register.

5. Days and hours for public inspection

The registers maintained pursuant to section 9 (1) to (3) of the law referred to in section 2.1 above are open for public inspection during normal weekdays from 10:00 to 16:00 hours. By prior telephone arrangements, another time for inspection may be arranged.
